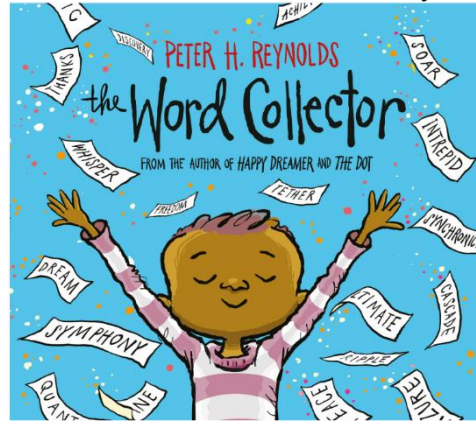


To Parents and Carers,
