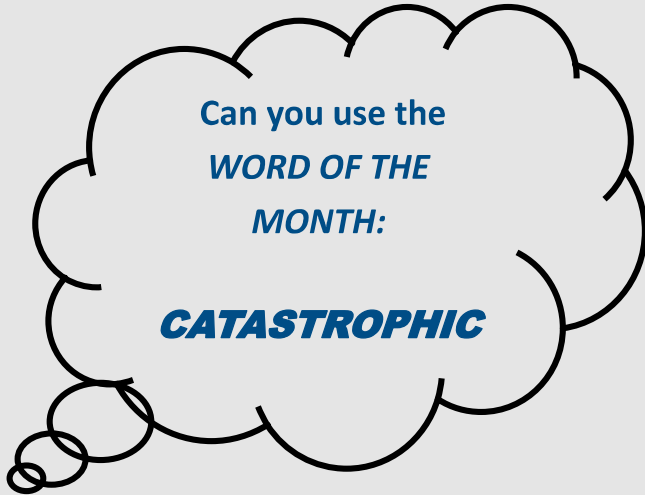

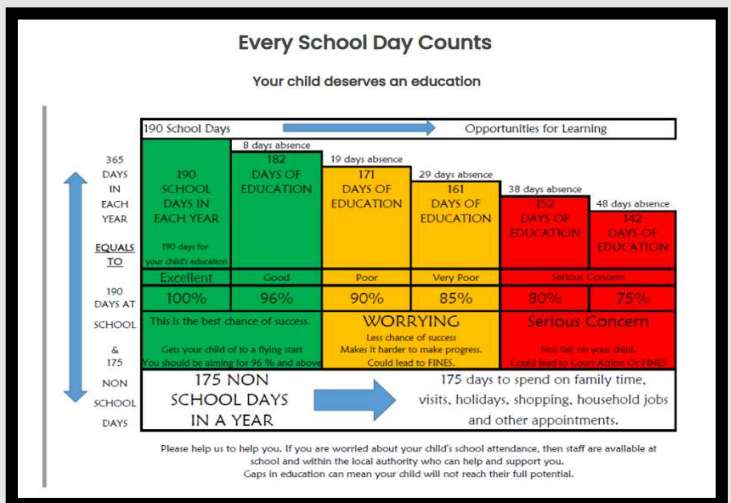
Dear Families,

For oracy to be embedded across the school day, and for the children to be confident and articulate.

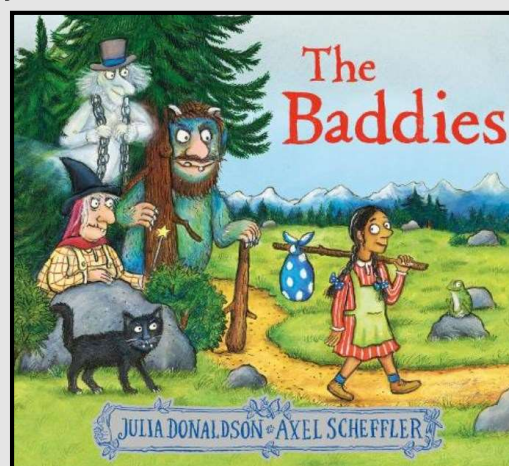
