Dear Families,

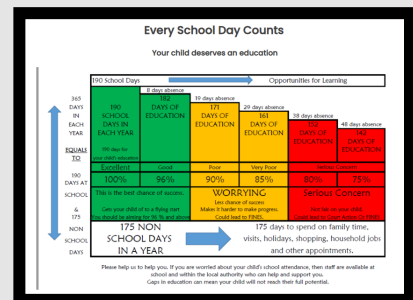
